
CPAP 2.0 Success Story



When Kevin Medina, a previous Nebraska VR client, received an outreach letter about the Career Pathways Advancement Project (CPAP 2.0), he jumped at the chance to go back to school. He and his Career Pathways Recruiter wrote a plan where he could address barriers and be successful. With accommodations including a laptop, mouse, and office chair, he begin by pursuing an Associate's Degree in Business Administration with an emphasis in Accounting. He graduated in August of 2024. Kevin is now a full-time student at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln and working to stack credentials to pursue work that can be done remotely should his health decline.
